Bleeding Control for the Injured (B-Con) is a National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) course that teaches basic life-saving medical interventions, including bleeding control with a tourniquet, bleeding control with gauze packs or topical hemostatic agents, and opening an airway to allow a casualty to breathe.

The course is designed for non-tactical law enforcement officers, firefighters, security personnel, teachers and other civilians requiring this basic training.

This pre-conference offering is FREE to attend, and will be capped to 24 participants on a first come, first served basis.
